



### BON VOYAGE

Horizon Power Catamarans says its owners will often toss lines and cruise for several months at a time, and as such, its yachts are designed for extended stays with a high level of redundancy of critical systems; efficient, seakindly and relatively shallow-draft hull forms; and voluminous interior and exterior spaces for long-haul comfort. Currently, its model range runs from 52 to 74 feet length overall.

### HORIZON PC60 / 61'7" LOA 24'6" MAX. BEAM

● **Experienced** is a good word to describe Horizon Power Catamarans, which has designed and built its power cats for 38 years. The Horizon PC60 can be ordered with an enclosed or open flybridge that measures 22 feet wide by nearly 45 feet long. Construction is resin-infused fiberglass via the SCRIMP system. ● **Power** is twin 705 hp Cummins QSM11s, giving the PC60 a reported 24-knot speed with a 20-knot cruise. Twin MAN diesels up to 850 hp are optional and increase that top-end speed to about 27 knots. With a 1,000-gallon fuel capacity, this cat has a 540-nautical-mile range at 18 knots and up to 1,500 nautical miles at 9 knots, according to the builder. ● **Design** elements include panoramic windows in the main-deck master stateroom. The salon's L-shaped settee and coffee table morph into a dining table. Belowdecks accommodations for guests or family members include an en suite VIP forward to starboard; a stateroom to port with twins or a king berth, and an optional en suite head; and either a twin-berth stateroom or crew's quarters in the portside hull. Woods, finishes, fabrics, stones and marbles are all customizable.
