Long-range cruisers go the distance in comfort and style.

Ready to move on from day trips? Set your sights on the distant horizon with these luxurious vessels that can go at least 1,100 nautical miles at cruising speed. With one hull or two, these 16 boats are made for long-haul adventures.



Horizon FD90

Horizon's best-selling range is the FD, and the series' most popular model is the FD90. The voluminous Fast Displacement vessels designed by Dutch designer Cor D. Rover have space galore, and the 90-foot FD90 (23'3" beam) has the most in-demand features, like a main-deck master, beach club option, and floor-to-ceiling salon windows. Below the waterline is the secret to her performance: a high-performance piercing bow juts forward from the hull, improving the ride and efficiency. At half-load, cruising at 10.5 knots, the FD90 has a 1,300-nautical mile range. The newest FD90, Hull No. 29, is the first one to have an open galley and a split-use skylounge, which boasts a huge covered deck behind the enclosed bridge. horizonyacht.com
